
Direct Support Professionals Celebration and Raffle

Covid-19 Vaccine and Boosters

CLO continues to encourage all staff to become vaccinated. Approximately 55% of our employees are currently vaccinated and our initial objective is for 75% of our workforce to become fully vaccinated. New hires must be vaccinated or be willing to become vaccinated if they are offered a position at CLO.

Michigan Department of Health and Humans Services (MDHHS) is urging Michiganders to get a booster shot if they received Pfizer's COVID-19 vaccine. This includes people ages 65 and older; individuals 18 through 64 years of age at high

risk of severe COVID-19 due to underlying health conditions; and those at high risk of COVID-19 due to occupational or institutional exposure – which includes all CLO employees.

Pfizer boosters are now available - if you are at least six months past the completion of your initial vaccination series. The easiest method is to register with Walgreens, or other participating pharmacies, on-line and boost your immune system ASAP!

We are hopeful that the Moderna booster will be approved soon and arrangements have been made for boosters to be given by Gull Pointe at our group homes.

Relias

Do you want to look through Relias courses and take a class to update your skills? It's easy!! Log into Relias and select " Learner" on the right hand side of the page underneath your name. On the left hand side of the page highlight "Course Library", which will bring up all 761 courses that Relias offers. Just scroll down (and arrow key over when you reach the bottom of the page) and click on "Enroll". On the left hand side of your page highlight "Assignments" and the course you just selected will be available on the main screen under "Electives". Relias is a great way to find out more about skills to help you with your job - from computer skills to interpersonal skills, time management and diagnostic information!!
